This class is very interested in letter formation. They like to practice it in our room. Please enforce proper letter formation when they are at home. Especially in their name. Use one capital letter and then all lower case. We are currently practicing our last name.

Also, we will continue to work on some sight words. We have been working on color sight words. We have gotten much stronger on this. It is still a bit of a challenge but we will continue to reinforce these skills through practice and games.
